Winter 2022-23 CONSTRUCTION PROGRESS!



Beginning the first week of July, the Fisher House Foundation construction contractor began construction of the Mid-Missouri Fisher House near the main entrance of Truman VA Hospital. Much of the exterior work has been completed, and the contractor is now finishing up the interior spaces and installing the plumbing, electrical, HVAC, elevator, walls, ceiling and flooring. Once the construction is completed, all furnishings including a full kitchen and laundry will be installed.

Upon completion, hopefully by May 2023, the House will be donated to the Truman VA Hospital, which will then assume responsibility for staffing, utilities, maintenance and operations. The Mid-Missouri Fisher House will include 16 family suites, a kitchen, laundry area and dining and living rooms. That means 16-32 family members can be served at any time. We hope to begin receiving guests this summer!

New Fisher House Manager on board!

Meet Truman VA's New Fisher House Manager!

Terry Woodcock, MAED, currently serves as Fisher House Manager at Harry S. Truman Memorial Veterans' Hospital. Mr. Woodcock assumed his new position on Jan. 15, 2023.

Prior to his new role, Mr. Woodcock served in several leadership positions within the U.S. Department of Defense/Commander Naval Installations Command. These include Area Manager of Family Housing for Commander Fleet Activities, Sasebo, Japan; Installation N9 for the Commander of Fleet Activities, Okinawa, Japan; Lodging Manager of Navy Gateway Inns & Suites, Okinawa, Japan; Command Master Chief for the Commander of Fleet Activities, Okinawa, Japan; Command Master Chief, USS John S. McCain DDG-56, Yokosuka, Japan.



Born in St. Kitts, West Indies, Mr. Woodcock immigrated with his parents at an early age to the U.S. Virgin Islands where he completed his primary and secondary education. He joined the U.S. Navy after high school and went to basic training (boot camp) in Orlando, Florida. He attended Hospital Corpsman "A" school in Great Lakes, Illinois, followed by Field Medical Service School in Camp Lejeune, North Carolina. After that training, he was assigned to the labor and delivery ward of U.S. Naval Hospital Guantanamo Bay, Cuba. Numerous other assignments followed, to include Military Entrance Processing Station, Sioux Falls, South Dakota, and Laboratory School in San Antonio.

During his Navy career, Mr. Woodcock also served on numerous ships to include the USS Hewitt DD-966, USS Essex LHD-2, USS Belleau Wood LHA-3, USS San Jose AFS-7, USS Niagara Falls AFS-3, USS White Plains AFS-4, and USS John S. McCain DDG-56. These ship tours allowed him to travel to numerous locations around the world to include Asia (such as Singapore, Thailand, Malaysia, Hong Kong, Japan, Indonesia, the United Arab Emirates, and the Philippines), South America, the Middle East (such as Egypt), Europe (such as Italy), the Red Sea, Djibouti, Mexico (such as Mazatlán and Puerto Vallarta), and Hawaii - to name a few.

Mr. Woodcock retired as a Master Chief Petty Officer from the U.S. Navy in 2010 after 31 years of honorable service.

An avid cyclist, he spends most of his free time exploring the country on one of his bikes. He also enjoys playing the piano and organ.
